Course Description to Be Delivered

CompTIA A+

This is the industry preferred qualification credential for technical support and IT operational roles. A+ sets the foundation for a career in IT and expands the students' knowledge of PC hardware and repair, troubleshooting and problem-solving skills, basic networking, and operating system security. This course supports the ability to connect users to the data they need to do their jobs regardless of the devices being used.

CompTIA Network+

This course builds off the technical support foundation and helps develop the skills needed for a career in IT infrastructure. It explores a wide variety of techniques and concepts used in troubleshooting, configuring, and managing internal networks. The purpose of this course is to ensure future IT professionals have the knowledge and skills to design and implement functional networks, configure and manage essential network devices, use devices such as switches and routers to segment network traffic, and implement network security standards and protocols.

Cisco CCNA Routing and Switching

This course introduces the architecture, structure, functions, components, and models of the internet and computer networks. The principles of IP addressing, and fundamentals of Ethernet concepts, media, and operations are introduced to provide a foundation for the curriculum. Cisco CCNA is the industry standard certification for aspiring Network Administrators.

Azure 900 – Microsoft Azure Fundamentals

This course is designed for candidates looking to demonstrate foundational level knowledge of cloud services and how those services are provided with Microsoft Azure. It is intended to validate traditional infrastructure and networking knowledge and push those concepts into a cloud infrastructural environment. Students will be exposed to the basics of cloud system and network administration.

Soft Skills for IT Professionals

This course covers a variety of soft skills that IT professionals need to be successful in their roles, including: communication, teamwork, managing conflict, and more. These are the skills hiring managers look for in candidates to determine if they have what it takes to succeed in the workplace
